Origin

Cross of Honeycrisp by unknown, bred by the Institute for Breeding Research on Fruits in Dresden-Pillnitz

Fruit

Size: medium to large

Form: obloid, medium depth of eye basin, weak crowning at calyx end

Skin: green to yellow, rare with small parts of orange red over color, can be russeted

Eating quality: firm flesh, juicy, crisp, sweetish, aromatic, excellent

Ripening time: beginning of October

Flower and fertilization

Medium blooming time, medium flower set

Yield

Moderate, moderate thinning recommended

Tree

Growth: medium strength, spreading, well ramified

Precocity: early

Diseases: resistant to scab (Rvi_{HC1}), less susceptible to powdery mildew

Intended use

Pia41 is a cultivar with a fantastic bite, very juicy and crisp with a long storability and an excellent shelf life
