#### Origin

Cross of Honeycrisp by unknown, bred by the Institute for Breeding Research on Fruits in Dresden-Pillnitz

### Fruit

Size: medium to large

Form: obloid, medium depth of eye basin,

weak crowning at calyx end

**Skin:** green ot yellow, rare with small parts of

orange red over color, can be russeted

Eating quality: firm flesh, juicy, crisp, sweetish,

aromatic, excellent

Ripening time: beginning of October

#### Flower and fertilization

Medium blooming time, medium flower set

#### **Yield**

Moderate, moderate thinning recommended

#### Tree

Growth: medium strength, spreading, well

ramified

**Precocity:** early

Diseases: resistant to scab (Rvi<sub>HC1</sub>), less

susceptible to powdery mildew

#### Intended use

Pia41 is a cultivar with a fantastic bite, very juicy and crisp with a long storability and an excellent shelf life
